BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

Milton S. F. Curry was born in Fresno, California. He obtained a Bachelor of Architecture degree from Cornell University in 1988 and a Master in Architecture post-professional degree with distinction from Harvard Graduate School of Design in 1992 with a concentration in architecture theory. Professor Curry began his teaching career at Arizona State University, where he was an assistant professor from 1992-1995. In 1995 he became a visiting assistant professor at Cornell University Department of Architecture, where he was promoted to an assistant professor in 1995 and a tenured associate professor in 2002. In 2010, he left Cornell upon his appointment as associate professor with tenure at the University of Michigan Taubman College Architecture Program. He has also held teaching positions at Harvard University Graduate School of Design, where he taught a graduate design studio in 1999 and was an instructor in the Harvard Career Discovery program in 1991. Professor Curry has coordinated graduate and undergraduate design studios at all levels, and has taught topical seminars on subjects ranging from architecture and cultural theory to urbanism and housing. His teaching pedagogy is guided by a focus on student engagement and a desire to inspire students to utilize a culturally-informed set of theoretical practices in their design thinking.

Professor Curry has been at the forefront of emerging sub-disciplinary areas of work on race, architecture and urbanism that engages cultural theory and humanities research. As an architectural designer he has engaged in strategic projects including an invited exhibition project at the Studio Museum in Harlem, speculative large-scale urban real estate and redevelopment work in Oakland California, and speculative work for DefJam entertainment company, among others. As a scholar/writer, Curry has lectured widely and has written influential essays for both academic and public audiences. His founding and editing of *CriticalProductive* Journal from 2008 to the present, and co-editing *Appendx* Journal from 1993-1999 has put him at the forefront of curating, editing and mentoring designers and scholars whose work on topics of race, ethnicity, gender, sexuality, and urbanism is collectively disrupting the canons of architecture and creating a new sub-field of architecture theory.

As an academic thinker engaged in leading and administering key initiatives at Cornell and University of Michigan, Curry was appointed by Cornell Provost Bidy Martin to lead the Cornell Council for the Arts (CCA) from 2002-2008; appointed by U-M Taubman (U-M) dean Monica Ponce de Leon as associate dean at U-M Taubman College from 2010-2015 and reappointed to serve from 2015-2020. In these positions, Professor Curry has led collaborative initiatives to enliven the arts on campus through diverse speaker series and curated arts and industrial design installations (CCA). He has led major academic initiatives in areas of urban design and advanced degrees in technology, conservation and design/health (U-M), and has worked successfully to start new programs that expand architectural knowledge exchange with humanities disciplines and partners in South America and Latin America (U-M). In addition, he has led non-profit fundraising initiatives that have benefited students, faculty and high school students (U-M). Collectively, he views academic administration as an intellectual project.
