

**Architecture BS, BDA, and BA
2009/2010 4-Year Sample Plan**

(intended only as a guide)

- Students must register for 13 or more credits each term. Freshmen who want to graduate in four years must take 15 credits each term (or 30 credits per year).
- Architecture degrees are sequential and require 3-4 years of coursework beginning with year one in the pre-architecture program, and regardless of previous credits. Students cannot earn more than one architecture degree over time.
- Good STUDY ABROAD terms for architecture students are year three or fall term of year four, including May session and summer session.
- * Graduation with an arch BA degree in CLA requires proficiency in a second language equivalent to two college years in college, so begin language study as soon as possible.
- ** Students must earn a master of architecture (M. Arch) degree in MN in order to become a licensed architect. MN only offers a 3 year M. Arch degree
