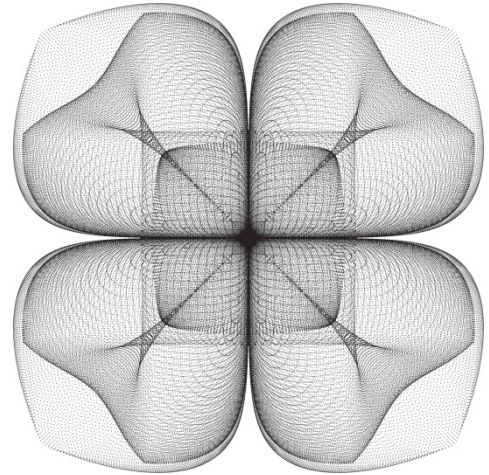
A Catalog of Difference

Parking

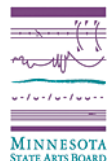
