R.T. Rybak served as mayor of Minneapolis from 2002 to 2013. During his tenure, R.T. led efforts to make Minneapolis a national leader in innovative, cradle-to-career approaches to youth development, and worked to highlight the crisis of our region's achievement gap and advance effective strategies for ending it.

He is currently head of Generation Next, a partnership of education, community, government, and business leaders aimed at closing the achievement gap between white and minority students. He also holds a joint appointment at both the Humphrey School of Public Affairs and the College of Design as a distinguished visiting practitioner. His first class, Mayor 101, explored the political, administrative, design, and bureaucratic challenges of running one of the largest and most dynamic cities in the United States.

A Minneapolis native, R.T. Rybak spent almost 30 years working in journalism, the commercial real estate business, publishing, and the Internet before being elected mayor in his first run for public office. He and his wife Megan O'Hara, a communications consultant and local-food advocate, have two grown children.

Susan Watkins is a teacher, designer, researcher, and author, as well as a mentor to a generation of students in the field of functional apparel design. She attended Pennsylvania State University and earned her B.S. in 1965 in consumer services in business, a program geared toward fashion merchandising. She continued in graduate school studying textiles and clothing at the same institution and earned her M.S. in 1967.

As a college student, Watkins, though interested in clothing design, was searching for meaning in the design process beyond the apparent frivolity of fashion design. No programs existed at this time to satisfy these needs, and Watkins spent her years as a university professor establishing this field of study at Cornell University and in influencing its adoption across the country. She was a Professor of Textiles and Clothing at Cornell University from 1967 to 1998.

As the most significant researcher and educator in the field, she remains a leading inspiration to many generations of designers, scholars, engineers, and teachers.

Candidates for Degrees

This program contains the names of College of Design students who have applied to graduate from fall semester 2013 through summer 2014. This is not an official University of Minnesota graduation list.

To graduate with distinction, a student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher at graduation. To graduate with high distinction, a student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.90 or higher. Graduation with designated Latin honors (cum laude, magna cum laude, summa cum laude) is limited to students who participate in the University of Minnesota Honors Program. Students must complete honors requirements, including a capstone or thesis project in their major, and, in their last 60 University of Minnesota credits, maintain a 3.50 GPA for cum laude, a 3.66 GPA for magna cum laude, and a 3.75 GPA for summa cum laude honors. Candidates for academic honors are noted in this program.

Students graduating with the Community Engagement Scholar distinction have completed at least nine credits of service-learning coursework, at least 400 hours for community service, and a series of reflective pieces. They have also completed an integrative community project that results in the creation of a sustainable project for a community organization.
