Graduation with *high distinction* is limited to the top three percent of the class; *distinction*, the next seven percent of the class. Graduation with designated honors (*cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *summa cum laude*) is limited to students who participate in the College Honors Program. Students must complete at least two academic honors options, a capstone project or additional honors options, and maintain a 3.40 GPA for *cum laude*, a 3.60 GPA for *magna cum laude*, and a 3.80 GPA for *summa cum laude* honors.
