#### DAVID A. RUBIN

David A. Rubin is the Founding Principal of Land Collective and recipient of the 2011–2012 Rome Prize in Landscape Architecture from the American Academy in Rome. His visionary contribution to the field in "empathy-driven design" is a hallmark of the studio, gaining increasing notoriety for fusing issues of social justice in cities with excellence in the design of public spaces. His work has received awards and honors from the American Society of Landscape Architects and the American Institute of Architects.

#### CANDIDATE FOR DEGREES

This program contains the names of College of Design students who have applied to graduate from fall semester 2016 through summer 2017. This is not an official University of Minnesota graduation list.

#### **HONORS**

Graduation with designated Latin honors (cum laude, magna cum laude, summa cum laude) is limited to students who participate in the University of Minnesota Honors Program. Students must complete honors requirements, including a capstone or thesis project in their major, and, in their last 60 University of Minnesota credits, maintain a 3.50 GPA for cum laude, a 3.66 GPA for magna cum laude, and a 3.75 GPA for summa cum laude honors. To graduate with distinction, a student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher at graduation. To graduate with high distinction, a student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.90 or higher. Candidates for academic honors are noted in this program.

#### **DEGREE IN 3**

Students graduating with the Degree in 3 distinction have participated in a University pilot program in Graphic Design or Retail Merchandising allowing them to obtain their baccalaureate degree in 3 years, or 8 consecutive semesters including summers.

#### PRESIDENT'S EMERGING SCHOLARS

The President's Emerging Scholars (PES) program is a four-year opportunity for select undergraduate students with diverse backgrounds and characteristics. There are approximately 310 students from various colleges graduating from the PES program this spring. Graduates are honored with a purple commencement cord.
