#### TAMARA EAGLE BULL, FAIA, NCARB, AICAE

Tammy Eagle Bull, FAIA, NCARB, AICAE, became an architect in fulfillment of a long-term family vision. Long before she was born, her grandfather told her father and uncle that one of them should go to architecture school and the other should study law. His reasoning was that someday their Oglala Lakota community in Pine Ridge, South Dakota, would need architects and lawyers and it would be best if those professionals came from within. Racism in the 1950s impacted these career opportunities, and it would be a generation later when Tammy fulfilled her grandfather's wish as an architect working with her tribe.

Tammy is the co-founder of Encompass Architects, P.C., a national firm headquartered in Lincoln, Nebraska. She received the Master of Architecture degree from the University of Minnesota—Twin Cities, and is recognized as the first Native American woman to be licensed in the United States. She is an enrolled member of the Oglala Lakota nation. Tammy has 30 years of experience and has received the designation of Fellow within the American Institute of Architects (AIA). This honor distinguishes those who have made a significant contribution to the profession and society, and who exemplify architectural excellence. In 2018, Tammy was the recipient of the AIA's Whitney M. Young, Jr., Award for her work with Native American communities. The award honors an architect who embodies social responsibility and actively addresses a relevant issue.

#### THE UNIVERSITY MACE

The University's first official mace made its debut in 1961 at the inauguration of Meredith Wilson (1960–67), 110 years after the University was founded and eight centuries after the mace's warlike image faded and it became a symbol of peaceful leadership. Art professor Philip Morton designed the University's mace, choosing a star as its crowning feature. The University machine shop made the mace with a solid aluminum handle set with the regents' seal and a 4-inch crystal sphere surmounted by the aluminum "Star of the North." Cuningham, FAIA, alumnus of the College and founder of Cuningham Group Architecture, has long been a champion of innovative, sustainable, people-driven design, while demonstrating a firm commitment to equity in the profession.

#### CANDIDATES FOR DEGREES

This program contains the names of College of Design students who have applied to graduate from fall semester 2018 through fall semester 2019. This is not an official University of Minnesota graduation list.

#### **HONORS**

Graduation with designated Latin honors (cum laude, magna cum laude, summa cum laude) is limited to students who participate in the University of Minnesota Honors Program. Students must complete honors requirements, including a capstone or thesis project in their major, and, in their last 60 University of Minnesota credits, maintain a 3.50 GPA for cum laude, a 3.66 GPA for magna cum laude, and a 3.75 GPA for summa cum laude honors. To graduate with distinction, a student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher at graduation. To graduate with high distinction, a student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.90 or higher. Candidates for academic honors are noted in this program.

#### PRESIDENT'S EMERGING SCHOLAR

The (PES) program is a four-year opportunity for select undergraduate students with diverse backgrounds and characteristics. There are approximately 400 students from various colleges graduating from the PES program this spring. Graduates are honored with a purple commencement cord.
