

Edge Sander



Work-piece **MUST** sit flat on the table and firmly against the stop/mitergauge.

Be certain the belt is correctly mounted. The belt must track in the center of the drums and platen.

Check the guards and table adjustments to see that they are in the correct position and securely locked in place.

Small and irregularly shaped pieces should be held in a hand clamp, special jig, or fixture.

Move your work-piece as you sand so that it doesn't burn or clog the abrasive.

Always use a backer block or other technique when sanding thin pieces on the belt sander.

Do not use power sanders to form and shape parts if the operations could be better performed on other machines.

Sand only clean, new wood.

Do not sand work that has wet glue or finish on the surface. These materials will load and foul the abrasive.
